Dear Competitor/Team Manager

After a long winter break, we are now only four weeks away from the start of the 2007 season. I am pleased to report that we have sold 12 more cars, taking us from 31 to 43 now in the UK.

2007 Regulation Changes

It is very important that you download the 2007 regulations from the website and read them thoroughly.

Television Coverage

We have TV coverage at all UK organised races plus the 25 hour race at Spa in July. All programme times will be on the website under "Latest News" throughout the season.

If you have purchased an in-car camera system for your car, please let me know, as Sky TV are always looking for new and exciting footage. If Sky use yours, this will also be a fantastic opportunity to promote your team/sponsor.

Reminder

It is mandatory that all drivers wear a Uniroyal badge on their race overall. Any tyre badges other than Uniroyal MUST be removed or completely covered. Also, any teams using a truck to transport their race car, must fly a Uniroyal flag from it, whilst at the circuit. If you require the Uniroyal overall badge or flag, please let me know immediately.

Petrol Quality

A reminder to all teams that they must NOT use 95 Octane fuel. We recommend Shell 98 Octane V power.

Croft Hotels

Due to the serious lack of security, poor standard of accommodation and

appalling service at the Blackwell Grange, we can now recommend an alternative hotel, The Tall Trees, which is approximately 8 miles from the circuit, tel 01642 387100. Or The Croft Hotel 2 miles from the circuit, tel 01325 720319.

The provisional race timetable for the Croft weekend is displayed on the website in the "latest news". To date, we do not have the "exclusive testing" times, but would anticipate starting at around 3.00 pm on the Friday. As soon as I have confirmation, these will be posted on the website.

Hospitality

Due to popular demand, we will be having another Hog Roast in the Fun Cup awning on the Saturday evening. As usual, each team will be allocated 6 yellow wristbands for Saturday and 6 red wristbands for Sunday. Please remember to wear the appropriate wristband for the duration of each day. Replacement and additional wristbands may be purchased at a cost of £16.00 each, but we must have at least 10 days' notice for any additional ones please.

Wine

As more and more ladies seem to be joining in the fun, we will be offering red and white wine by the bottle, which must be ordered in advance from the Fun Cup office.

Tickets

As usual, all tickets, wristbands and pit garage allocation, should be collected from the Fun Cup awning on the Friday.

BRSCC

Every driver must either be a member of the BRSCC or register the car as a member. Car membership costs £235,

which is normally the most cost effective way.

Registration

If you have not already done so, you need to register for the series. The registration forms are on the “Downloads” page on the website.

Race Entries

All race entries are on the website. Simply complete the entry form online and click “send”, it’s as easy as that! Due to the large number of cars we now have in the UK, it is important that your entries are submitted early to avoid disappointment. Entries will be accepted on a “first come first served” basis.

Parts

As most of you know, for your convenience, we will have a parts truck at all the UK events, including Mondello and Spa. If you are already aware prior to the race meeting, that you require any bulky parts, such as bodywork, tyres, wheels etc., these must be ordered in advance.

All that remains is for me to welcome you all back for another season of fantastic racing and also to wish a warm welcome to all newcomers to the series. You are in for a real treat!
