

ANGLESEY CIRCUIT - GENERAL TESTING



Welcome to Anglesey Circuit. Please read these notes carefully and enjoy your day with us.

1. Test day driver sign-on will take place in the bottom on the control building from 0700.
2. No engines to be run before 0845 and no unnecessary revving, please.
3. No vehicles to be driven on circuit outside of operational hours. On Thursday evening, walking or cycling is OK, but no engines (this includes electric bikes/scooters). Please be aware there may be circuit staff on track. On Friday, please do not go out on track between the end of the closed wheel open pit lane session and the night time practice as circuit staff will be busy putting down cats eyes and it will be assumed you are coming out to help!
4. Access to the circuit is via the Pit Lane. Enter Pit Lane from Paddock at right hand end – near the old Sign-On office – left hand opening. Return to the Paddock at beginning of Pit Lane – first opening. The Assembly Area is only used on race days.
5. If sessions are run, please be in the pit lane in good time for your session. It will start whether you are there, or not.
6. Please show your wristband to the pit lane marshal.
7. When leaving the pit lane, please don't cross the yellow blend line until you have built up track speed. When leaving the circuit, please signal early and clearly when entering the Pit Lane. Again, do not cross the blend line. Vehicles where all four wheels leave the track will be reported and be shown a black flag. Drivers in receipt of two black flags will take no further part in the day's activities. Please don't cut corners ... the circuit is 12 metres wide (which should be ample). Continual running wide or corner cutting covers the track with debris, is unfair on your fellow drivers, is dangerous and will lead to less testing time for you, as we will need to sweep the circuit in your time. Drivers new to Anglesey circuit, are invited to attend a briefing in driver sign-on at 0845 or 1330.
8. Signed on instructors (grade 'A' or 'S' only) will wear pink coloured wristbands.
9. All testing will be on the 2.1 mile International circuit with the exception of dedicated Fun Cup sessions which will be 1.55 mile Coastal circuit
